

Eligibility Requirements

In order to be considered for services provided by PACE of the Southern Piedmont, you must meet the 4 criteria listed below.

- Be 55 years of age or older
- Be determined to need nursing home level of care
- Be able to live in a community setting at the time of enrollment, without jeopardizing health or safety
- Reside in Mecklenburg, Cabarrus, Union, or Stanly Counties



Program Cost

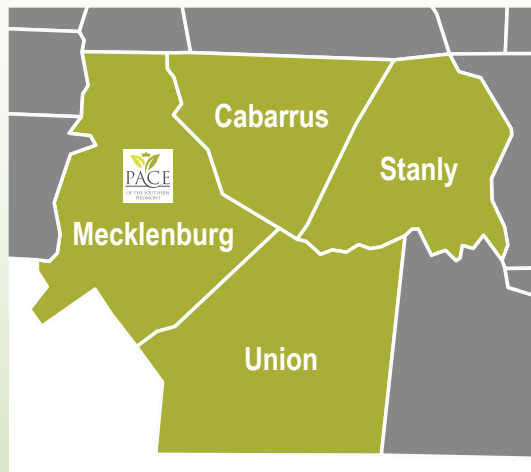
